**Navidad Valley CattleWomen
2026 Scholarship Rules**

The Navidad Valley CattleWomen Scholarship is awarded to one or more high school Seniors each year. Scholarships awarded are based on scholastic achievement, leadership in agriculture, civic and community activities, financial need, and an ability to contribute to agriculture in the future.

- Applicant must be a resident of Lavaca, Fayette, or Colorado counties or attend a high school in Lavaca, Fayette, or Colorado counties.
- At time of application, applicant must be a Senior in high school or the equivalent thereof.
- **Your Application MUST include:** (1) This completed application form (2) A copy of your **original** high school transcript through mid-term of your senior year, including rank and GPA (3) A one page, minimum 300 word, essay regarding your agricultural influences and goals, involvement in the beef industry and future goals in life (4) 3 photos of yourself (page provided) of activities you participated in with a brief caption by each. **“See Resume” showing activity listings will not be accepted.**
- **Original** Applicant, Parent/Guardian and Counselor **signatures are required** on the 1st page of the application.
- The winning applicant(s) will be paid a one-time award to be used toward tuition or other education-related expenses. The scholarship must be accepted in the year that it is won. If this does not occur, the scholarship money will be returned to the Navidad Valley CattleWomen Scholarship Fund.
- The winner may be asked to attend the spring Navidad Valley CattleWomen’s monthly membership meeting.
- Payment of the scholarship will be made when the Scholarship Chairman for Navidad Valley CattleWomen has received your **acceptance letter**, and at a later date, **proof of enrollment (i.e. class schedule or fee slip with name of educational institution)** at an accredited college, university, or technical school. Scholarship recipients will be chosen by Navidad Valley CattleWomen Scholarship Committee Members.

Helpful Hints

1. This application takes time to complete fully. Do not expect to complete it in one weekend. Start now, and do a little at a time before activities begin that require a lot of your time. There are **instructions** at the top of each required page. **Follow them and save all of your work!**
2. **Follow all directions** when typing within the text boxes. Most recent activity first. Use statements, not complete sentences. **Refer to the examples.** ALL information provided is to be done **within the boxes and lines provided.** **DO NOT PUT "SEE ATTACHED" IN ANY BOX.** **3 Pictures are to be scanned onto the page provided with a brief, descriptive statement beside each. The only additional page, outside of the pages provided to you, will be your official school transcript.** Any variance from the guidelines will cause your application to not be considered.
3. Focus your efforts on the **Essay.** Once you have written it, you may want to ask a **parent, teacher or advisor to critique** it for grammar, spelling and content. Remember, no less than 300 words. Use complete sentences with proper grammar and punctuation in your Essay.
4. The entire application should be solely your work. We want to learn about your thoughts, ideas and experiences. Requesting advice is encouraged, but we do not want to know the opinions of a textbook, teacher or your parents. **Any use of AI is prohibited with zero tolerance.**
5. Refer to these helpful hints and Scholarship rules to make sure that you have **completed all information and required signatures.**
6. The scoring of applications is based on a point system, **so being thorough and following the guidelines is important. POINTS for following instructions!**

1. Completed Application 2. All required signatures 3. Attached official transcript
